

HARVEST SAVINGS THIS FALL

As the seasons are changing, we invite you to fall into savings with Liberty. We believe in empowering you, our customer, with the knowledge as well as some practical tools to help you see the savings add up. Included you will see tips and practices to help you use water efficiently, a state drought status update, as well as a variety of water efficiency programs that can help you save water this fall. Liberty is proud to be a conservation partner and we are always ready to help our customers make efficient water choices.

FALL/WINTER IRRIGATION SCHEDULE & TIPS

As the weather cools off and the days become shorter, plants lose less water through evaporation and therefore need less water. Changing your landscape watering times each season to fit the needs of your landscaping is important so that your plants are not overwatered.

Watering Times: The time of day you water is important to adjust as temperatures drop.

Fall – Before 9:00 a.m. or after 6:00 p.m.

Winter – Morning time, after the sun comes up. Avoid watering in the evening or at night as that can increase the risk for plant disease.

Remember: If it is raining, turn off your irrigation system! If you receive at least ½" of rain, you can even skip your next irrigation cycle.

Planting:

Fall – Late September to November is the best time to plant!

- Plant native and drought tolerant plants.
- Use organic mulch around plants, especially around trees to help retain moisture.

Winter – It's best to wait until early spring for planting. New growth is vulnerable to cold nights in winter.



DID YOU KNOW?
Did you know that Fall is the best time to plant?

Pruning and Maintenance:

Fall – Prune dead limbs, clean away brush, and clean leaves from gutters.

Winter – Resist pruning plants in winter, even if the cold nights and frost can turn some parts of your vegetation brown. Those parts protect the plant's interior from further damage. Trim the damaged parts in late February or early March.

Additional Tips and Best Practices:

- Eliminate runoff from outdoor irrigation by ensuring your irrigation system is aligned correctly.
- Use a shut-off hose nozzle when using a hose.
- Refrain from washing driveways or sidewalks and use a broom instead.
- Fix indoor and outdoor leaks to limit water waste.
- Use water saving devices indoors and outdoors.

FALL/WINTER WATER GUIDELINES

Below are watering guidelines for fall and winter based on vegetation type. These guidelines are for established plants, additional water is needed for new plantings.
