Beat the Peak

From April 15 through September 30, 2025, Liberty encourages customers to practice voluntary water conservation. Here are some simple ways to save water:

- Adjust irrigation schedules to water before 6 a.m.
- Adjust sprinklers so only your landscape is watered (not the house, sidewalk, or street)
- Upgrade existing irrigation system with weather-based controllers or drip irrigation.
- Use mulch around shrubs and trees to retain moisture and reduce runoff.
- Check for and repair leaks inside and outside your home.
