



Water Efficient Practices

- Adjust your irrigation controller to irrigate your lawn before 6 a.m.
- Upgrade existing irrigation systems or landscaping with tools such as weather-based controllers or drip irrigation.
- Use mulch around shrubs and trees to retain moisture and reduce run-off.
- Use a pool cover to reduce evaporation, decrease the amount of time you spend refilling your pool, and keep it cleaner.
- Check for and repair leaks inside and outside of your home.
- Make behavioral water conservation changes such as turning water off while brushing your teeth or taking shorter showers.
- Replace water-using equipment with higher efficiency models. Look for the WaterSense and ENERGY STAR labels.
