INDOOR CONSERVATION



Install or replace your faucet aerators. Save 1-2 gallons per minute.



Take a 5 minute shower. 10 gallons of water are used for a 5 minute shower, 30+ gallons for a bath.



Turn water off while brushing your teeth. Save 2-4 gallons every time you brush your teeth.



Don't let the water run while washing dishes. Save 8-20 gallons of water.



Only run full loads of dishes and laundry. Save up to 15 gallons per load.

OUTDOOR CONSERVATION



Plant native, waterefficient shrubs, trees, and grasses.



Water lawn and plants early in the morning. In the morning there is less water lost to evaporation and wind.



Don't cut more then 1/3 of your lawn's length at one time. Taller grasses hold moisture better.



Use mulch around
your shrubs and trees
It will retain
moisture, reduce
run-off, moderate soil
temperature, and
help with weed
control.



Use drip irrigation on your plants.



If you use a spray nozzle on the end of your hose, it can save water while you wash your car, your pets, and other outdoor water activities.

SMART IRRIGATION SYSTEM

Smart Irrigation systems tailor watering schedules and run times automatically to meet specific landscape needs. These controllers significantly improve outdoor water use – saving water and money.

DRIP IRRIGATION

Drip irrigation is a type of watering system to save water by allowing water to drip slowly to the roots of plants. The system will place water directly into the soil, on the roots, to minimize evaporation and water efficiently. HANDWATERING

If you have to hand water, make sure you use a soil probe or long screwdriver and plunge it into the soil to ensure the moisture is 6 – 10 inches deep. This will make sure you do not overwater. Overwatering can lead to root rot and soil compaction that robs the roots of oxygen.
